TERMS OF REFERENCE

Ministry of Information Technology and Telecommunication is entrusted to formulate policies aimed at improving National Information and Communications Technology (ICT) infrastructure and services, to transform Pakistan into a knowledge based economy by ensuring provision of reliable and affordable Information and Communications Technology enabled services. In this regard, this Ministry invites application from dynamic professionals for the post of **TECHNICAL ADVISOR – MP-I SCALE**, as per details given below:

JOB SPECIFICATION

A. **QUALIFICATION:**

Ph.D in Computer Science/Information Technology/Software Engineering/Computer Engineering/ Information System (ICT related disciplines) from HEC recognized local or international university of high ranking.

<u>OR</u>

Master's Degree in Computer Science/Information Technology/Software Engineering/Computer Engineering/ Information System (ICT related disciplines) from HEC recognized local or international university of high ranking.

EXPERIENCE:

Candidates with Ph.D are required to have fourteen (14) years post qualification experience in the relevant field including three years of senior management level positions.

Candidates with Master's Degree are required to have eighteen (18) years post qualification experience including three years of senior management level position.

The candidate's professional credentials should include the following:

- i. Envisaging and formulating project proposals pertaining to Computer Science/Information Technology/ Software Engineering/ Computer Engineering/ Information System Security/IT Management/Computer Information System in collaboration with related international and/or regional organizations.
- ii. Designing and implementation of Information Technology Tools and Information Management Systems and processes.
- iii. Implementation of IT & Telecom development programs through effective monitoring and control mechanisms/tools.
- iv. Policy and program reviews and evaluations.
- v. Drafting of various IT & Telecom related bills/legal documents.

- vi. Designing and implementing of various capacity building programs for IT & Telecom professionals.
- vii. Extensive knowledge of various IT & Telecom related policies, rules and regulations, relevant market players and national & international market dynamics.
- viii. Ability to communicate and interact with Senior Government Officials and other stakeholders effectively and excellent People Management Skills and to work with Public Sector Leadership.
- ix. Strong Technical, Analytical and Problem-Solving Skills to anticipate the critical technical and legal issues and to offer counter solutions.
- x. Ability to explore, study, and evaluate the existing direction and standards of the IT & Telecom industry in the country and to make necessary recommendations.
- xi. Ability to plan, develop and evaluate IT related programs for the Ministry.

B. AGE LIMIT:

Maximum 62 years (to be calculated as on the closing date of submission of applications)

C. **DURATION:**

Appointment of the Technical Advisor shall initially be made on contract for three years which will be extendable for a further two years (year to year basis) on the recommendation of Performance Evaluation Committee in accordance with prescribed performance evaluation of MP Scale positions.

D. **DISQUALIFICATION:**

No person shall be eligible for appointment as Technical Advisor, who:

- a) has been or is dismissed from service as a consequence of disciplinary proceedings;
- b) has been or is convicted, by a court of competent jurisdiction, for an offence involving moral turpitude;
- c) either at the time of appointment as Technical Advisor or thereafter during such appointment was not or is not a citizen of Pakistan; or
- d) Benefits from the National Reconciliation Ordinance, 2007 (LX of 2007).

E. MANNER OF APPOINTMENT:

- a) The appointment shall be made as per prescribed procedure of appointment in MP-I Scale position.
- b) The vacancy of the Technical Advisor shall be uploaded by the Ministry of IT and Telecom on its website and also advertised at least in two national leading newspapers of nation-wide circulation.
- c) A shortlisting Committee shall be constituted with the approval of Secretary, IT and Telecom, for shortlisting of applications.
- d) The Selection Committee/Board for appointment in the MP Scale shall recommend three most suitable candidates out of the shortlisted candidates and a summary shall be submitted for decision of the Prime Minister, accordingly.

E. JOB DESCRIPTION

Under the overall supervision of the Minister-in-Charge and the concerned Secretary, Technical Advisor will be responsible to carry out, but will not be limited to, the following tasks for the Ministry of IT & Telecom and its allied Organizations (Department/Corporation/Company

- i. Review the existing IT & Telecom Policies, Frameworks, Infrastructure, Constitutional Provisions and Rules of Business of the Ministry to identify the issues/gaps and suggest improvements / revisions thereof to optimally implement the mandate of the Ministry.
- ii. Study the latest Global and regional IT & Telecom related Best Practices with special focus on countries with similar socio-economic background in the field of IT & Telecom, and propose the relevant guidelines along with customized implementation strategies for the local industry
- iii. To oversee development programs of IT & Telecom sector in respect of the MoITT & T and the organizations under its administrative control with a view to:
 - a. Provide technical advice on the overall IT & Telecom related Public Sector Development Programme (PSDP) projects.
 - b. Initiate and facilitate regular technical meetings on national level to review program implementation and identify the measures/strategies to overcome Implementation bottlenecks.
 - c. Review Monitoring & Evaluation mechanism for IT & Telecom related development projects.
- iv. Assist in designing the framework for promotion of research and innovation through USF and R&D Companies.
- v. The Technical Advisor appointed under these rules when acting or purporting to act in pursuance of any of the provisions of these rules shall be deemed to be a public servant within the meaning of section-21 of the Pakistan Penal Code (Act XLV of 1980).

J. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:

The contract of Technical Advisor may be terminated by giving one month's notice on either side or payment of one month's basic pay in lieu thereof.

K. MONITORING AND EVALUATION:

The performance of Technical Advisor shall be monitored by Secretary and Minister/Minister of State Minister In-charge. The Technical Advisor shall to the Secretary, IT and Telecom
