## 1. Introduction & Background

The Asan Khidmat Markaz (AKM) initiative is a flagship citizen facilitation program of the Government of Pakistan aimed at delivering integrated public services through digital platforms and physical facilitation centers. The initiative involves multiple stakeholders including MoITT, ICT implementation partners, infrastructure executing agencies such as CDA, and participating federal and provincial departments.

Given the scale, sensitivity, and public importance of AKM, MoITT intends to engage a reputable and independent third-party firm to conduct a comprehensive audit and validation of the initiative.

## 2. Objectives of the Assignment

- Assess compliance with approved scope, architecture, and policies
- Evaluate technical robustness, security posture, and operational resilience
- Review governance, controls, and risk management mechanisms
- Assess service delivery effectiveness and citizen experience
- Review alignment of financial expenditures across multiple stages and entities
- Identify gaps, risks, and improvement opportunities
- Provide practical and prioritized recommendations

## 3. Applicable Rules & Procurement Method

This procurement shall be governed by the Public Procurement Rules, 2004. This RFP is issued on a restricted basis for MoITT pre-qualified firms only. In case of any inconsistency, PPRA Rules shall prevail.

## 4. Scope of Work

### 4.1 Technical & System Audit

- Audit of application, database, middleware, and integration architecture
- Review of source code management and deployment practices (where applicable)
- Assessment of system scalability, availability, performance, and fault tolerance
- Verification of system documentation (SRS, SDS, architecture diagrams)

### 4.2 Information Security Audit

- Assessment of access control, authentication, authorization, and audit logging
- Review against applicable standards (ISO 27001, OWASP, NIST where relevant)
- High-level vulnerability and security posture assessment
- Evaluation of data protection, backup, and disaster recovery mechanisms

### 4.3 Process, Governance & Compliance Audit

- Validation of end-to-end service workflows
- Review of governance and decision-making structures
- Compliance with approved scope, policies, and procedures
- Assessment of vendor management and SLA oversight

#### 4.4 Operational & Service Delivery Audit

- Evaluation of service workflows and turnaround times
- Assessment of integration with participating departments
- Review of operations at selected AKM centers
- Assessment of grievance redressal and feedback mechanisms

#### 4.5 Financial & Value-for-Money Review

- Review of financial alignment with approved PC-I and scope
- Identification of multi-stage financial responsibilities (CDA, ICT, operations)
- Assessment of coordination among stakeholders
- Program-level value-for-money assessment
- This review shall not constitute a forensic audit or bill verification

Participation is restricted to firms pre-qualified by MoITT. Bidders shall submit a declaration of independence and conflict of interest. No fresh eligibility documentation or bid security is required.
